ISU Physics Scholarship Description:

The ISU Department of Physics and the Idaho Accelerator Center (IAC) will grant an undetermined number of \$3,000 scholarships to incoming ISU first year physics majors.

Summer Internship Description:

The ISU Department of Physics and the IAC will host an undetermined number of high school student interns. The internship positions begin June 11th and end July 6th, for a total of 4 weeks, or until July 20th, for a total of 6 weeks if an extension is granted. All interns will be paid \$9.00 per hour based on a 40 hour work week and will be provided with room and board on campus. Additionally, all interns will receive a summer scholarship for Idaho State University credit Physics 481, Independent Problems. The internships are competitive and applications must be received by March 5th, 2012.

Applicant Qualifications:

- Must be a current high school student
- Must be a minimum of 16 years old on June 11th, 2012.
- Must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative high school GPA
